Featured presenter, Greg Judy, is from Clark, MO. He and his wife Jan run a grazing operation on 1,520 acres of leased and owned land. The Judys went from near bankruptcy in 1999 to paying off a 200 acre farm and house in 3 years with custom grazing on leased land and are completely debt free. Holistic High Density Planned Grazing is used to graze cows, cow/calf pairs, bred heifers, horses, and stockers. During this workshop, Greg will share his knowledge of **growing and managing winter stockpile, monitoring animal performance, building healthy soil through mob-grazing, securing economical grazing leases, and multi-species grazing**.
